This cookie policy describes how Works In Progress ("Works in Progress") uses "cookies" and other similar technologies, in connection with our Site and Media Services. Any capitalized term used and not otherwise defined below has the meaning assigned to it in our Privacy Policy.

1. What is a Cookie?

Cookies are small text files that are stored in a computer's browser directory. They help site providers with things like understanding how people use a site, remembering a User's login details, and storing site preferences.

2. Does Works In Progress use Cookies?

Yes. We use cookies in accordance with our Privacy Policy to:

- ensure that our Media Services function properly, and
- detect and prevent fraud.

3. Who sets cookies when I use the Works In Progress's Site?

There are two main types of cookies that can be set:

- First party cookies: these cookies are placed and read by Works In Progress directly when you use our Media Services.
- Third party cookies: these cookies are not set by Works

In Progress, but by the Wordpress Service. Wordpress is used to host the Site and its content. These cookies are required in order for the Site's functionality to work as expected.

4. How Works In Progress Uses Cookies

Duration

Cookies play an important role in helping us provide effective and safe Media Services. Below is a description of the types of cookies set through our Site and the purposes for which they are used.

Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential to the operation of our Site and Media Services and make them usable and secure by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the Site. We use these cookies in a number of different ways, including:

- Security. To protect user data from unauthorized access.
- Functionality. To keep our Site and Media Services working correctly, like showing you the right information for your selected location.
